HALL IN THE TOWNSHIP OF BLANDFORD-
BLENHEIM TO BE OF HISTORIC AND
ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OR INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, C. 337, authorizes Council of a municipality to designate property within the municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS Council for the Corporation of the Township of Blandford-Blenheim deems it desirable to designate Wolverton Hall to be of historic and architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the Township of Blandford-Blenheim has caused Notice of Intention to Designate to be given in accordance with Section 29(3) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, C. 337;

AND WHEREAS no Notice of Objection has been served on the Clerk within the meaning of Section 29(5) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, C. 337.

NOW THEREFORE ~~THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF~~
THE TOWNSHIP OF BLANDFORD-BLENHEIM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. The property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto is hereby designated to be of historic and architectural value and interest.
2. Section 33(1) of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, C. 337 shall apply only to the following:
 - (a) glass cupola on the roof, double veranda on the north side of house, painted glass around front entrance.
 - (b) circular staircase, exterior brickwork.
3. This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Blandford-Blenheim.
