NOTICE

TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act R.S.O. 1980, the Corporation of the Township of Collingwood intends by by-law to designate the Ravenna Hall as a building of historical or architectural interest. Said building being situated on part of Lot 16, Concession 8 in the Township of Collingwood in the County of Grey.

In 1872 the Township bought the property and erected the Township Hall, a graceful structure of grey limestone resembling period churches and schools.

It was used for Council meetings during the summers until 1961 and even today is used for political meetings and Township social activities and is known to many as the Ravenna Community Centre.

Any person who wishes to object to the proposed designation, shall within 30 days of the publication herein, serve on the Clerk of the Township, a Notice of Objection, setting out the objections and all relevant facts thereto.
