Reasons for the Proposed Designation

The Old Kentvale Store, built in 1912, has played a significant role in the history of the Township. The building housed the Kent family general merchandising operation from 1912 to 1932 and was the location of the Kentvale Post Office until the late 1920's. This building also housed the switchboard for the "Huron Line" telephone system, one of the first party lines in Canada, which later became part of the Farmer's Co-operative Telephone System, the first rural phone system in Ontario.
