BY-LAW NO. 37-94

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A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 62-90, BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE PART LOTS 1 AND 2, CONCESSION 10, (CHARLOTTEVILLE) AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND/OR HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST

WHEREAS By-law No 62-90 designated the property municipally known as Part of Lots 1 and 2, Concession 10, geographic Township of Charlotteville, County of Norfolk, now in the Township of Delhi, Regional Municipality of Haldimand-Norfolk;

AND WHEREAS, the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, Chapter O.18, Section 32(1) states that an owner of property designated under this part may apply to the Council of the municipality in which the property is situate to repeal the by-law or part thereof designating the property. or part thereof designating the property;

AND WHEREAS the owner of the property has requested and applied to the Council of the municipality to amend the designating by-law;

AND WHEREAS the Council has sought and received consultation from its Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee;

AND WHEREAS the Council has consented to pass a by-law amending Bylaw No 62-90;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Delhi hereby enacts as follows:

- That Schedule "B" of By-law 62-90 be amended as follows:
 - Delete the following features from designation: the original entry door, transom and sidelights and the original windows.
- That the fourth paragraph of Schedule "B" now reads as 2. follows: "Designation of the Collyer/DeMaere house, Lot 2, Concession 10, former Township of Charlotteville, under the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, is recommended by the Committee. The following features are noted specifically for their architectural significance:
 - all brick elevations and their foundations,
 - original entry door hood mould,
 original window hood moulds,

 - zinc roof.
- That a copy of this by-law shall be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper Land Registry Office at Simcoe, Ontario.
- That the Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the property described in Schedule "A" and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of this By-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality.
