NOTICE OF  
INTENTION  
TO DESIGNATE**

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Corporation of the Village of Bayfield intends to designate the property known as the Hunter Residence at the municipal address of Plan 147, lot 194, as a building of architectural and/or historical significance, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

**Building:** [REDACTED], residence

**Address:** 1 Anne Street

**Date:** Circa 1850

**SIGNIFICANCE:** The Corporation intends to designate the property described above and specifically the house with addition built circa 1850, the barn, the chicken coop and the wire fence with pussy cat gate latches. It is intended that the house, out-buildings and the fence be preserved in its present form including paint colour ie; white with red trim.

The house is deemed to be of social and architectural interest having been a harness shop, wagon and woodworking shops. It is one of the few frame two storey buildings basically unaltered since 1850.

**ANY PERSON** may within thirty days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Village of Bayfield notice of his or her objection and all relevant facts. If such Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Bayfield shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
