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

BY-LAW NO. 2007-20

OF

*The Corporation of Norfolk County*

**BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE INDUSTRY FARM/POOR HOUSE/COUNTY HOME/BURYING GROUND INCLUDING THE LANDS AND 28 GRAVE MARKERS, BEING PART OF LOT 16, IN THE GORE, GEOGRAPHIC TOWNSHIP OF WOODHOUSE, NORFOLK COUNTY, DESIGNATED AS PART 1, 37R-9582, MUNICIPALLY LOCATED BEHIND 500 QUEENSWAY WEST, SIMCOE, NORFOLK COUNTY, AS BEING OF CULTURAL HERITAGE VALUE AND INTEREST.**

**WHEREAS** Subsection 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate a property within the municipality, including all buildings and structures thereof, to be of cultural heritage value and interest;

**AND WHEREAS** notice of intention to designate the Industry Farm/Poor House/County Home/Burying Ground, including the lands, being Part of Lot 16, in the Gore, Geographic Township of Woodhouse, Norfolk County, designated as Part 1, 37R-9582, municipally located behind 500 Queensway West, Simcoe, Ontario, within Norfolk County, was served on the owner of the Industry Farm/Poor House/County Home/Burying Ground and on the Ontario Heritage Trust and such notice was published in the Simcoe Reformer, a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** the reasons for designation are set out in Schedule "A" hereto;

**AND WHEREAS** no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;


**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF NORFOLK COUNTY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The property known as the Industry Farm/Poor House/County Home/Burying Ground including the lands and 28 grave markers, being Part of Lot 16, in the Gore, Geographic Township of Woodhouse, Norfolk County, designated as Part 1, 37R-9582, municipally located behind 500 Queensway West, Simcoe, Ontario, within Norfolk County, is hereby designated as being of cultural heritage value and interest;
2. That the Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the Land Registry Office of the Land Registry Division of Norfolk;

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- 3. That the Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be served on the owner of the property described in Schedule "A" hereto and on the Ontario Heritage Trust and to cause notice of this By-law to be published in the Simcoe Reformer.
- 4. That the effective date of this By-law shall be the date of final passage thereof.

**SCHEDULE "A"**

**TO BY-LAW 2007-20**

**REASONS FOR DESIGNATION**

The property, including the lands and 28 grave markers, located behind 500 Queensway West, Simcoe, Ontario, being Part of Lot 16, in the Gore, Geographic Township of Woodhouse, within Norfolk County, designated as Part 1, 37R-9582, is recognized to be of historical significance due to its fascinating history of the local social welfare. As the final resting place for a proportion of the County's homeless, orphaned, needy, elderly and mentally ill, the 219 recorded burials here are poorly represented by a collection of 28 markers which were dug out of a plantation of pine trees and laid flat in a cement pad in the early 1970's.

Careful research by members of the Norfolk Branch of the Ontario Genealogical Society have identified, to date, 372 persons who died at the Poor House/County Home. A great deal of other useful information about the residents is included in this research.

This burial site is located on County property. It should be officially recognized, suitably marked and appropriately cared for.

The specific reasons for its designation are to:

- recognize the burial site as an official cemetery within Norfolk County
- appropriately mark the burial site
- ensure that the burial site will be maintained
- ensure that the burial site and land beyond the cement pad, containing unmarked graves will not be sold or developed.
- ensure public access to the burial site
- have signage on Queensway West to indicate the burial site
- recognize the efforts of the Norfolk Branch of the Ontario Genealogical Society in the preservation of this burial site
