

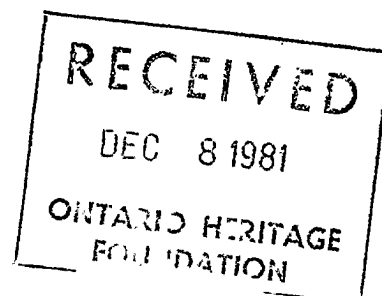

A by-law of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa to repeal By-law Number 240-79.

WHEREAS The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, Statutes of Ontario, 1974, Chapter 122, as amended, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact a by-law to designate real property, including all the buildings and structures thereon, to be of historic or architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation enacted By-law Number 240-79 entitled "A by-law of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa to designate 66 Robert Street to be of historic or architectural value or interest" on the 5th day of September, 1979;

AND WHEREAS Section 34 of the said Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 further authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact a by-law to repeal a by-law which designates property;


THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

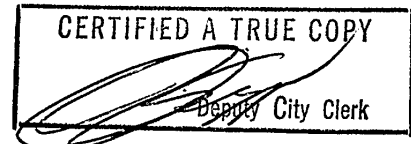
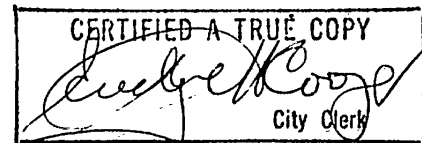

66 ROBERT STREET

ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the City of Ottawa, Regional Municipality of Ottawa-Carleton and Province of Ontario, and BEING COMPOSED OF namely,

PART of Lot 76 on the east side of Robert Street on Plan M-4 filed in the Office of Land Titles, Ottawa, lying west of a line formed by the prolongation in a straight line across the said Lot 76 of the boundary between Lots 71 and 72 on the south side of Frank Street on said Plan M-4, and
