

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF BRACEBRIDGE

BY-LAW 82 - 64

BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW 78-53 AS IT RELATES TO PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS PART OF LOT 3, CONCESSION 1, IN THE TOWNSHIP OF MACAULAY, NOW IN THE TOWN OF BRACEBRIDGE DESIGNATED AS PART 1 ON PLAN 35R-7300, AND PART OF LOT 30, REGISTERED PLAN M-3 DESIGNATED AS PART 12 ON PLAN 35R-7300, and PART OF BIRD LANE RESERVED, REGISTERED PLAN M-3 DESIGNATED AS PART 13 ON PLAN 35R- 7300

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, authorizes the council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all the buildings and structures thereon to be of historic or architectural value or interest, and provides for the repeal of such by-laws;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Bracebridge has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as The Bird House at 45 Muskoka Road and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of its intention to repeal by-law 78-53 as it applies to lands described in Schedule "A" and attached hereto, and has caused such notice of intention to be published in a newspaper having a general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS the reasons for repealing such By-Law as it relates to the lands described in Schedule "A" attached hereto are set out in Schedule "B" attached hereto;


AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed repeal has been served on the clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Bracebridge enacts as follows:


1. By-Law 78-53 of The Corporation of the Town of Bracebridge insofar as it relates to the lands described in schedule "A" hereto is hereby repealed.
2. The Town Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper Land Registry office at Bracebridge, for Muskoka.
3. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served upon the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of this by-law to be published each of 3 consecutive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in the Town of Bracebridge.


