





HERITAGE DESIGNATION

The Council for the Corporation of the Town of Bracebridge intends to pass a by-law in accordance with Section 29, of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter).18 to designate the hose tower which formed part of the original town hall from 1881 to 1957.
