



WHEREAS section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 (R.S.O. 1980, c. 337, as amended) authorizes the council of a municipality to pass by-laws designating properties within the municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has given notice of its intention to so designate the property known as the Canadian Pacific Railway station building, located on part of the east half of Lot 4, Concession 4, West of Hurontario Street in the City of Brampton, in accordance with the requirements of section 29(3) of the said Act;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection has been served upon the Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Brampton within the time limited for so doing, as set out in section 29(5) of the said Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The property known as the Canadian Pacific Railway station building and described in Schedule A to this by-law is hereby designated to be a property of historic and architectural value and interest.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 22nd day of February , 1982.

The land situated in the City of Brampton, in the Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Chinguacousy, in the County of Peel), being part of the east half of Lot 4, Concession 4, West of Hurontario Street, designated as Part 1 on a reference plan in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as number 43R-9318.
