



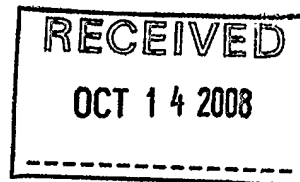



NOTICE OF AMENDMENT OF DESIGNATION

The Council of the Municipality of Clarington, at their meeting held on September 29, 2008 passed By-law 2008-163 to amend the heritage designation of 19 King Street East, Bowmanville under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18:

This by-law is amended by deleting the words "the beautifully paneled door on the west side is surmounted by a transom composed of a pair of Gothic arches" in the third paragraph.

PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO AMEND HERITAGE DESIGNATION

The Municipality of Clarington intends to amend By-law 90-185 which designated 19 King Street East, Bowmanville, Ontario as a property of architectural and historical value under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18.

This amendment will remove the reference to the panelled door on the west side of 19 King Street East to allow for the replacement of the door with a replica with the same visual attributes while maintaining the door's present dimensional properties and door surround, including the overhead transom. The existing door will be held in trust or donated for preservation.

Any person may send by Registered Mail or deliver to the Municipal Clerk of the Municipality of Clarington, notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a notice of objection is received by August 29, 2008, the Council of the Municipality of Clarington shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
