

BY-LAW NUMBER *648-78*

A By-law to repeal By-law No. 476-77, a by-law to designate the "Hammond House" pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Mississauga enacted and passed on August 15, 1977, By-law 476-77, a by-law to designate the "Hammond House" at 2625 Hammond Road to be a building of historical and architectural value pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act; and

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of Mississauga, on October 28, 1977, received an application from the owners of the "Hammond House" for a demolition permit; and

WHEREAS Council, pursuant to Section 34(2) of the Ontario Heritage Act, at its meeting on January 23, 1978, refused the application and prohibited any work to demolish or remove any building or structure on the property for a period of 180 days from the date of its decision; and

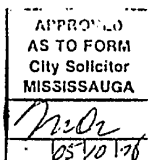
WHEREAS the 180 day holding period expired on July 23, 1978; and

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 34(5)(6)b of the aforementioned Act, By-law 476-77, designating the "Hammond House", must be repealed.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Mississauga ENACTS as follows:

1. That By-law 476-77, a by-law to designate the "Hammond House", located at 2625 Hammond Road, to be a building of historical and architectural value pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act, be repealed.
