Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The Bank of Commerce, built in the fall of 1905, is recommended for designation for architectural and historical reasons. This pre-fabricated two storey wood frame building, with its interrupted gambrel roof and inset porch, is Cobalt's Earliest surviving public building and one of the few remaining examples of the Bank of Commerce pre-fabs that once dotted Western Canada. Despite the changes in the porch columns, windows, porch stairs and sheathing material, this building, unique in the Cobalt area in its "West Cost" building style, retains much of its historic character.
