THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORWICH BY-LAW NO. 52-91

BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 58-88.

WHEREAS By-Law No. 58-88 was duly passed on the 27th day of September, 1988, to designate the property known municipally as The Freeman House, Lots 524 and 525, Plan 745, former Village of Norwich, as being of architectural and historical value or interest;

AND WHEREAS, as a result of approval of application for consent affecting the subject property By-Law No. 32-91 was duly passed on the 9th day of September, 1991, to designate The Freeman House;

AND WHEREAS it is now deemed necessary and expedient to repeal By-Law No. 58-88;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Norwich enacts as follows:

1. That By-Law No. 58-88 duly passed on the 27th day of September, 1988, be hereby repealed.
