

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORWICH

BY-LAW NUMBER 62-2009

TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 17-94, A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS THE BURTIS-LARMON HOUSE NORTH PART OF LOT 13, CONCESSION 2, IN THE FORMER TOWNSHIP OF NORTH NORWICH AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST

WHEREAS Council adopted By-law 17-94 to designate the property known municipally as the Burtis-Larmon House, north part of Lot 13, Concession 2, in the former Township of North Norwich as being of architectural and historical value or interest pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act";

AND WHEREAS resolution #23 was adopted by Council at its meeting held January 13, 2009 to repeal by-law 17-94";

AND WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990 as amended, Chapter O.18, Section 32(16) states that "...the Council shall pass a by-law repealing the by-law, or the part of the by-law, that designated the property as property of cultural heritage value or interest ...;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of The Township of Norwich hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-law No. 17-94, A By-law to designate the property known municipally as the Burtis-Larmon House, north part of Lot 13, Concession 2, in the former Township of North Norwich as being of architectural and historical value or interest pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act be hereby repealed.
- 2. That this by-law shall be effective upon the passing thereof.
