Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Village of Oil Springs intends to designate the property located at 4596 Oil Springs Line, Con 3 Lot 16 Con 3 E Pt Lot 16 Frmlly Pt Lt 22 Lts 23 & 24 Pt Lt 28 Lts 29-32 Incl Pl 2 Irr, known as the Community Hall as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1990, Section 29 (1), c. O, 18.

Any persons may, before the 11th day of September, 2007 at 5:00 p.m., send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk Treasurer or the Deputy Clerk Treasurer of the Village of Oil Springs, a notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. When Notice of Objection has been received, the Council of the Village of Oil Springs will refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing and report.
