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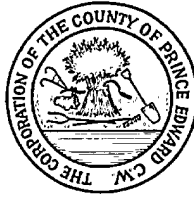

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTIES KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS I) LANDS MARKED "GLENWOOD CEMETERY", REGISTERED PLAN #24, TOWN OF PICTON, IN THE COUNTY OF PRINCE EDWARD, II) 332 MAIN STREET, LOT #7 LAND REGISTRAR'S COMPILED PLAN #25, TOWN OF PICTON, III) 334 MAIN STREET, LOT #7, LAND REGISTRAR'S COMPILED PLAN #25, TOWN OF PICTON, IV) PART 2 ON PLAN 47R-1843, LOTS #6 & 7, CONCESSION 1 SOUTH OF THE BAY OF QUINTE, TOWNSHIP OF NORTH MARYSBURGH AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE.

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1980 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the County of Prince Edward has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as I) Glenwood Cemetery Chapel and Receiving Vault, lands marked "Glenwood Cemetery", Registered Plan #24, Town of Picton, II) The Shire Hall, 332 Main Street, Lot #7, Land Registrar's Compiled Plan #25, Town of Picton, III) The Old County Registry Office, 334 Main Street, Lot #7, Land Registrar's Compiled Plan #25, Town of Picton, and IV) Van Alstine's Mill, Part 2 on Plan 47R-1843, Lots 6 & 7, Concession 1 South of the Bay of Quinte, Township of North Marysburgh and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PRINCE EDWARD enacts as follows:

1. There shall be designated as being of architectural and historical value and interest the real properties known as I) "The Glenwood Cemetery Chapel and Receiving Vault" lands marked "Glenwood Cemetery" Registered Plan #24, Town of Picton, County of Prince Edward, II) "The Shire Hall", 332 Main Street, Lot #7, Land Registrar's Compiled Plan #25, Town of Picton, County of Prince Edward, III) "The Old County Registry Office", 334 Main Street, Lot #7, Land Registrar's Compiled Plan #25, Town of Picton, County of Prince Edward, and IV) "Van Alstine's Mill", Part 2 on Plan 47R-1843, Lots 6 & 7, Concession 1 South of the Bay of Quinte, Township of North Marysburgh, County of Prince Edward.

2. The County Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the properties described above.

3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owners of the aforesaid properties and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause a notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED at Picton, Ontario this 21st day of June, 1983.
