COUNTY OF PRINCE EDWARD  
BY-LAW NO. 1885

---

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1628 BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN PROPERTIES IN THE COUNTY OF PRINCE EDWARD AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND/OR HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST.

WHEREAS the property known as the Prince Edward County Museum, the former 'old' St. Mary Magdalene Church, Church and Union Streets in the Town of Picton, more particularly described as all of Lots 1230, 1231, 1232 and 1246 according to the R.W. Hermon Registered Plan No. 24 of the Town of Picton.

WHEREAS the Prince Edward County Museum Board have formally requested that the designation placed on property be amended pursuant to Section 32 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337.

WHEREAS this request has been reviewed by the Prince Edward County Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee and they have recommended that the Prince Edward County Council consent to the Museum Board's request.

WHEREAS the Prince Edward County Council adopted the report and recommendation of the Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee dated May 31st, 1989 at a meeting held on June 29th, 1989 thereby consenting to the Museum's Board's request to amend the designation of the property.

THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF PRINCE EDWARD enacts as follows:

1. THAT By-Law No. 1628 be amended to include all lands incorporating the cemetery of the 'old' St. Mary Magdalene Church and, all grave stones, grave markers and iron railings located within the cemetery more particularly described as all of Lots 1230, 1231, 1232 and 1246 according to the R.W. Hermon Registered Plan No. 24 of the Town of Picton.
2. THAT the Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the Prince Edward County Museum Board and the Ontario Heritage Foundation.
3. THAT reference to the property be amended in the Municipal Register referred to in Section 27 subsection (1) of the Ontario Heritage Act R.S.O. 1980 Chapter 337.
4. THAT notice of this by-law be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality.
5. THAT the County Solicitor is hereby authorized to register a copy of this by-law against the real property as described in the foregoing in the Land Registry Office.
