NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

Take Notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Ameliasburgh intends to designate at the following municipal addresses as properties, including lands and buildings, of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S. O. Chapter 122

- (a) Lot 90, Plan. 2RM, Township of Ameliasburgh
(S.S. #12).

The old School at Ameliasburgh, c.1890, is an essential part of the village epitomizing the old country school house.

- (b) Lot 93, Conc. 1. Township of Ameliasburgh
(Albury Church).

Albury Church is principally of note for the architectural composition of the exterior, its exterior details and materials and for the interior of the church proper and its finishes and furniture. The building is also historically significant for its non-denomination background.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Township of Ameliasburgh before the 31st day of July, 1981.
