TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, R.S.O. Chapter 337:

#### Municipal Address

33 Centre Street East, Richmond Hill, Ontario (known as Methodist Manse)

#### Reasons for Proposed Designation

✓ This house is recommended for designation for historical and architectural reasons. Built by the Trustees of the Methodist Church in 1864, it served as the Methodist manse for 86 years.


The late Georgian east wing is of patterned brick (now painted) and has a 3-bay, side hall plan. The original 6/6 and 6/3 windows have flat radiating voussoirs; the front door has a 6-light rectangular transom and 3-light sidelights.

The c 1875 west wing repeats the patterned brick, with the west facade laid in Flemish bond. The 2/2 windows and peaked centre gable with drop finial are architectural features of the Picturesque style.]
