

Reasons for the Proposed Repealing By-law:

Due to the destruction of the house by fire on August 31, 1995, it is appropriate to repeal the designation by-law, By-law No. 4-93.

Any person who objects to the proposed repealing by-law shall, within 30 days after the day of first publication of this notice, serve on the Clerk of the Town of Richmond Hill, a notice of objection setting out the reason for the objection and all relevant facts.
