THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RICHMOND HILL

BY-LAW NO. 195-91

A By-law to Repeal By-law No. 205-90 (Stooks-Langstaff-Atkinson House)

WHEREAS Section 32 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact a by-law to repeal a by-law designating property under that Act upon application from the subject property owner;

AND WHEREAS the owner of the property known municipally as 10370 Yonge Street, Richmond Hill has applied to have the designation of the building situated thereon under the Ontario Heritage Act repealed;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF RICHMOND HILL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That By-law No. 205-90 is hereby repealed.
- That the Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this By-law to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality.
- 3. The Town Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be registered against the property described as part of Lot 48, Concession 1, and more particularly described as Part 1 on Plan 64R-3566, in the Land Registry Office
