



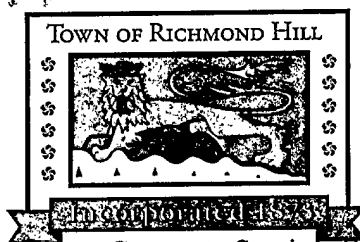

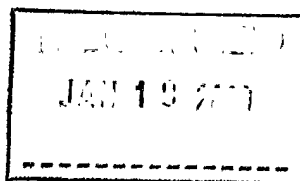

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Richmond Hill intends to repeal the by-law which designates the following property, including lands and building, as a property of historic or architectural value or interest, under Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18:

Historical Reference: The John Hoover III House

Reasons for the Proposed Repealing By-law:

Due to the relocation of the John Hoover III House to Thornhill, it is appropriate to repeal the designation by-law, By-law No. 113-98.

Any person who objects to the proposed repealing by-law shall, within 30 days after the date of publication of this notice, serve on the Clerk of the Town of Richmond Hill, a notice of objection setting out the reason for the objection and all relevant facts. Service may be made by delivery personally to the Clerk or by registered mail.
