NOTICE

TAKE NOTICE The Corporation of Loyalist Township proposes to repeal the bylaw designating lands and/or buildings as per Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

DESCRIPTION

The property involved is described as being in Loyalist Township (formerly geographic area of the Village of Bath) in the County of Lennox and Addington and the Province of Ontario, and being the property located at 353 Main Street in the Village of Bath also known as the Ham House.

REASONS FOR REPEAL OF DESIGNATION BY-LAW

The building is in an advanced stage of deterioration and is in urgent need of repair. Repeal of the designation by-law will allow a wider range of options to be pursued to stop the deterioration of the building and maintain the building as a significant component of the heritage fabric within the Village of Bath.

NOTICE OF OBJECTION

AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or agency may object to this proposed repeal of the designation by-law by filing with the Clerk of The Corporation of Loyalist Township not later than the 9th day of November 2009 a Notice of Objection including reasons in support of the objection.
