

CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF BATH

BY-LAW NO. 593/87

BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW No. 415/78

WHEREAS Section 32 of The Ontario Heritage Act 1980 authorizes the Council of a municipality to repeal a by-law or part thereof designating property;

AND WHEREAS By-law No. 415/78 designated the property known municipally as Concession 1, part lot 13, in the village of Bath, on which was situate the "building once owned by the Forwards";

AND WHEREAS in 1985 the property was purchased by one Ian Syme, and the "building once owned by the Forwards" was relocated to a municipal park where the building was subsequently vandalised and totally destroyed by fire in May 1987;

AND WHEREAS the actual property on which the "building once owned by the Forwards" was originally located, is no longer deemed to be of historical value;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF BATH ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 415/78 is hereby repealed.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 9th DAY OF NOVEMBER 1987.
