NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia intends to designate the property including lands and buildings, at the following Municipal address as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act 1990, Section 29 (1) Chapter O.18.

Reasons for Proposed Designation

Historical Reasons:

The Marthaville United Church was erected in 1880. When regular church services ended in 1928/29 the Marthaville Friendship Circle resumed responsibility of maintaining the building and held various functions there. With diminishing memberships this practice became very difficult. Because of the historical value of the building the Petrolia Discovery will move the church as a welcome edition to their Pioneer Village.

Architectural Reasons:

Contents to be included with the church are:

Pulpit – two gas stoves, piano and stool, two high back chairs, Communion table, Hymn books, Collection Plates, all plaques pertaining to building.

In the adjoining kitchen: Cook Stove, antique heater, wooden kitchen table, and wooden rack.

Also many records of antiquity

Any persons may before the 24th, September 1999, send by registered mail or deliver to the Administrator Clerk of the Town of Petrolia, notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. When a Notice of Objection has been received, the Council of the Town of Petrolia will refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing and report.
