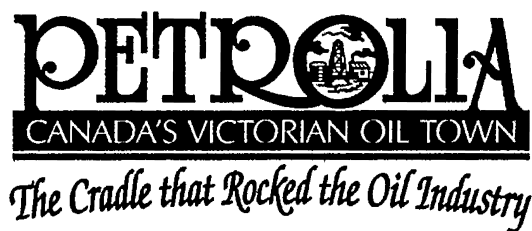



THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PETROLIA

BY-LAW NUMBER 28 - 2009

**A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY MUNICIPALLY KNOWN AS
440 EMMELINE STREET, IN THE TOWN OF PETROLIA, AS BEING OF
ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST.**

WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Part IV, s.29.1 authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact By-Laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest, and


WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia has caused to be served on the owner of the lands and premises of 440 Emmeline Street, in the Town of Petrolia, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality for one week; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk/Administrator of the Municipality;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia hereby enacts as follows:

1. This is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest of the real property known as 440 Greenfield Street, in the Town of Petrolia, Province of Ontario, more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto.
2. The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "B" hereto in the proper land registry office.
3. The Clerk/Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-Law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this By-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality.

By-Law Read a First, Second and Third time and Finally Passed this 27th day of April, 2009.

SCHEDULE "A"

Reasons for Proposed Designation

Historical Reasons:

Date of Construction: Circa 1896

Occupancy and/or role record:

Prior to 1988, this house was owned by the Diocese of Huron. Attached is a list of occupants beginning with Rev. Canon William Craig whose signature is seen on the attached mortgage. Originally built as the Rectory of Christ Anglican Church.


The Home was purchased in 1988 by [REDACTED]

Architectural Reasons:

440 Emmeline Street illustrates the Victoriantal style. In keeping with putting the best features to the most visible parts of the home, the Emma Street side features 3 beautiful round-headed windows while the Emmeline Street side has a lovely restored leaded glass over the large parlour window and another elliptical-shaped window in the front study. The north side of the house has slightly curved windows while the rear of the house has only plain rectangles. The home is triple brick. The veranda wraps around the northwest corner of the house and has an upper railing. The interior oak staircase rises from the first floor to the third floor.

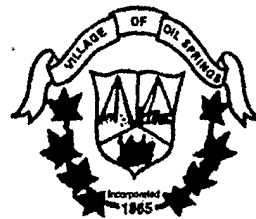
