NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pickering intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337:

Part Lot 19, Concession 5 The Bentley House

REASONS FOR DESIGNATION

Assessment records indicate that the Bentley House, located at the southwest corner of Brock Road and Highway Number 7, was completed in 1854. The entire facade of the Bentley House was built to impress. From the handsome cut stone foundations to the top of the bracketed belvedere, this multi-windowed house is imposing and a significant landmark in the Town of Pickering.

TAKE NOTICE that any person or agency may appeal this Notice by filing with the Clerk of the Corporation of the Town of Pickering a statement outlining the reasons for the objective within 30 days of the date of this Notice of Intention to Designate.
