# NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pickering intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.18.

Palmer-Voss House 2101Valley Farm Road Lot 20, Concession 2, Pickering

### **REASONS FOR DESIGNATION**

The Palmer-Voss House was built in two stages, the first during the 1850's, the second approximately 20 years later. It is of stone construction in the Gothic Revival style and a fine example of mid-19th century vernacular stone construction.

TAKE NOTICE that any person or agency may appeal this Notice by filing with the Clerk of the Corporation of the Town of Pickering a statement outlining the reasons for the objection within 30 days of the date of this Notice of Intention to Designate.
