BY-LAW NUMBER 20-82 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ST. MARYS

BEING a By-Law to repeal By-Law Number 31 of 1978, said By-Law "Being a By-Law to designate the property known municipally as the Queen Street Bridge crossing the Thames River and the Mill Race from Trout Creek on the North, under the small arch of the Bridge to the point where the water re-enters the Thames River South of the Bridge".

WHEREAS said By-Law Number 31 of 1978 designated under the Ontario Heritage Act the Bridge hereinbefore described "...as being of architectural value or interest...";

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Town of St. Marys now desires to repeal the said By-Law Number 31 of 1978 under Section 32 of the Ontario Heritage Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED as a By-Law of The Corporation of the Town of St. Marys that By-Law Number 31 of 1978 is hereby repealed.

FINALLY PASSED this 27th day of April, A.D. 1982.
