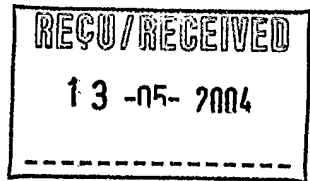

BY-LAW DESIGNATING LAKEVIEW CEMETARY MAUSOLEUM

Please be advised that Council at its Meeting of April 5th, 2004, adopted a by-law (By-Law # 39 of 2004) that designates the exterior structure of Lakeview Cemetery Mausoleum located in Lakeview Cemetery - 1016 Colborne Road, Sarnia, Ontario, as being worthy of heritage preservation under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18 as amended. 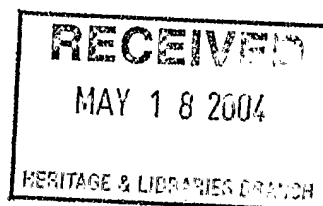

BY-LAW NUMBER 39 OF 2004
OF THE CITY OF SARNIA

"A By-law to designate the exterior structure of Lakeview Cemetery Mausoleum located in Lakeview Cemetery - 1016 Colborne Road, Sarnia, Ontario, as being of Historic or Architectural Value or Interest"

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18 as amended, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact By-laws to designate real property including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of historic or architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Sarnia has caused to be served on the owners of Lakeview Cemetery Mausoleum located in Lakeview Cemetery - 1016 Colborne Road, Sarnia, Ontario, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to designate the mausoleum, and has caused such notice of intention to be published in a newspaper having a general circulation in the municipality once for three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS the reasons for designation are set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;


NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Sarnia enacts as follows;

1. There is designated as being of historic or architectural value or interest the exterior structure of the real property more particularly described in Schedule "B" attached hereto, and known as Lakeview Cemetery Mausoleum (1016 Colborne Road).
2. The City Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be registered in the proper Land Registry Office against the lands described in Schedule "B" attached hereto, which are lands affected by this By-law.
3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be served upon the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this By-law to be published for each of three consecutive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Sarnia.
4. This By-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed.

SCHEDULE "A"

The Lakeview Cemetery Mausoleum was built by D. W. Mitchell Construction Company in 1921. The building is in the Greek Revival style, and is constructed of reinforced concrete with the exterior faced with stone, and the interior, with marble. There are three stained-glass windows – two matching on the north and south walls, and one on the east side of the building. This is the only cemetery mausoleum in the Sarnia area and one of the few remaining Greek Revival style buildings remaining in the city.



SCHEDULE "B"

DESCRIPTION

Lakeview Cemetery Mausoleum

All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the City of Sarnia, in the County of Lambton and Province of Ontario and being composed of part of Lot No. 63 in the Front Concession and the said City of Sarnia more particularly described as follows:

Premising that the easterly limit of the Colborne Road, being the original road allowance between Lots 63 and 64 having a bearing of N 02° 00' 00" E and relating all bearings herein thereto.

Beginning at the southwest corner of said Lot 63, thence N 02 00' 00" E, 540.00' along the said east limit of Colborne Road also being the west limit of said Lot 63.

Thence S 88 00' 00" E, 273.00' to the corner of a masonry mausoleum standing on the 20th, day of January, 2004 and the Point of Commencement.

Thence along the walls of the said mausoleum that following twelve (12) courses:

N 80° 08' E, 31.90'
S 09° 52' E, 38.20'
N 80° 08' E, 14.80'
S 09° 52' E, 31.20'
S 80° 08' W, 14.80'
S 09° 52' E, 38.20'
S 80° 08' W, 31.90'
N 09° 52' W, 38.20'
S 80° 08' W, 6.00'
N 09° 52' W, 31.20'
N 80° 08' E, 6.00'
N 09° 52' W, 38.20' to the Point of Commencement
