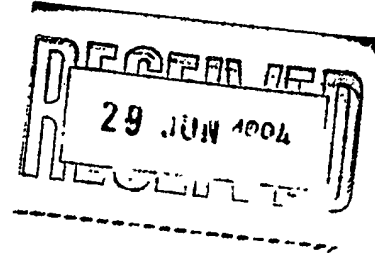

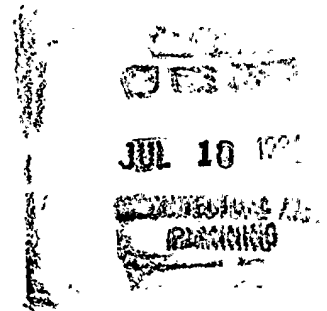

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE:

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Sarnia intends to designate the property, including lands and structures, at the following municipal address as property of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18.

PROPERTY **GRANITE MARKER, WEST END OF
DEVINE STREET**

REASONS FOR PROPOSED DESIGNATION:

The granite marker is recommended for designation for historical reasons. Installed in 1932 by the United Church of Canada, it denotes the site of the first church/school/mission building in Lambton County.

NOTE:

Any persons may, within thirty days of the first publication of this Notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Sarnia notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Sarnia shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
