NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE:

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Sarnia intends to designate the property, including lands and structures, at the following municipal address as property of architectural and/or historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18.

PROPERTY: LAMP POSTS AT FERRY DOCK HILL

REASONS FOR PROPOSED DESIGNATION:

These City-owned street light standards are recommended for designation for architectural reasons. Installed in the early 1920's the lamp posts are constructed of cast iron with acorn shaped glass refractors.

NOTE:

Any persons may, within thirty days of the first publication of this Notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Sarnia notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such Notice of Objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Sarnia shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
