PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 32 OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT R.S.O. 1990.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Sarnia is giving its **Notice of Intention to REPEAL By-law Number 9269**, a by-law which designates **166 Brock Street South** in the City of Sarnia as a property of cultural heritage value and interest.

Council approved the request of the owner to repeal the by-law at its September 14th 2015, Council Meeting.

APPEAL TO THE CONSERVATION REVIEW BOARD

Any member of the public may appeal the repeal of this by-law to the Conservation Review Board by filing a notice of appeal, setting out the reasons for the appeal, with the Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Sarnia, within 30 days of the publication of the notice in the local newspaper.

Any objections to this repeal of By-law 9269 must be filed no later than October 19th, 2015. Objections should be directed to the City Clerk's Office, City Hall 2nd Floor, 255 North Christina Street, P.O. Box 3018, Sarnia ON, N7T 7N2

The decision of the Council of the Corporation of the City of Sarnia is final if an appeal is not received on or before October 19th 2015.
