

REASONS FOR DESIGNATION OF 513 CENTRE STREET SOUTH

Historical

Both the original owner (Arthur Archibald) and the architect (S.J. Spall) of 513 Centre Street South had important roles in Whitby's past. Arthur Archibald was Principal of Whitby High School from 1927 to 1942 and an Inspector of Public Schools for South Ontario County from 1942 to 1959. S. J. Spall was Construction Supervisor for the Ontario Psychiatric Hospital and designed a number of institutional buildings in the Whitby area.

Architectural

The Archibald House is an interesting example of an early 20th Century suburban house with Gothic Revival and Tudor Revival features.

Any person may, before June 29, 1984, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Whitby notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such notice of objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
