TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings at the following municipal address as property of architectural value or interest under Part 4 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 337.

REASONS FOR DESIGNATION OF 132 DUNDAS STREET WEST

Historical

The Old Whitby Library Building was built by the Whitby Library Board in 1913. The building was financed by a grant from the Carnegie Foundation and the land was donated by the Ontario County Old Girls' Association. The building was officially opened on May 1, 1914 and served as the Town's library until 1973.

Architectural

The Old Whitby Library Building is a good example of the Beaux Arts Classical design commonly used for Carnegie libraries across North America. The design of the building is notable for achieving the monument of scale expected of Beaux Arts Classical buildings in what is essentially a small building . . . constructed without the use of expensive materials

Any person may, before March 1, 1985, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Whitby notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such notice of objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
