REASONS FOR DESIGNATION OF 170 MYRTLE ROAD EAST, WHITBY

HISTORIC

The Methodist Episcopal Church Parsonage was built in 1877 and was the home of the ministers for over 71 years.

ARCHITECTURAL

The Methodist Episcopal Church Parsonage retains its original storey-and-a-half L-Plan form with rear kitchen wing, narrow clapboarding, verandah treillage, finials and eaves trim.

Any person may, before November 29, 1991, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Whitby, notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with a statement of reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such notice of objection is received, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
