Please be advised that pursuant to By-law No. 05-364, as amended by By-law No. 07-322, which delegates the power to consent to alterations to designated property under the *Ontario Heritage Act* to the Director of Planning and Chief Planner, Heritage Permit Application HP2017-063 is approved for the designated property at 5 Brock Street North, Dundas, in accordance with the submitted Heritage Permit Application for the following alterations:

- Extension of previously approved and lapsed Heritage Permit HP2014-021, which includes the following proposed alterations:
 - Replacement of two (2) wood windows on the second floor with replica wood windows; and,

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
