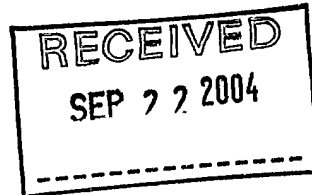

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WHITBY

BY-LAW NO. 5485-04

BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 1071-80 DESIGNATING THE STRUCTURE KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS 1453 HENRY STREET AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE AND INTEREST

WHEREAS, Section 31 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. 0.18, as amended, provides that the council of a municipality may pass by-laws repealing the designation of properties to be of cultural heritage value or interest;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby considers it desirable to repeal By-law No. 1071-80 designating the structure known municipally as 1453 Henry Street as being of architectural and historical value and interest;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby enacts as follows:

1. By-law No. 1071-80, designating the structure known as the Station Gallery located on property at 1453 Henry Street, Town of Whitby, and more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this by-law, is repealed.
2. The provisions of this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.

BY-LAW READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 13TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, A.D., 2004.
