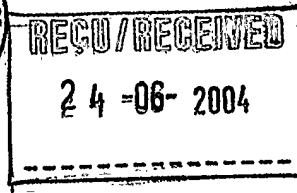

NOTICE OF INTENT
THE STATION GALLERY
1453 HENRY STREET, WHITBY, ONTARIO

The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby intends to repeal By-law No. 1071-80 designating the Station Gallery at 1453 Henry Street, Whitby, as being of architectural and historical value and interest.

The Station Gallery is to be relocated to the northwest corner of Henry Street and Victoria Street West. When the Station Gallery relocation and expansion project is complete it is the intention of Whitby Council to redesignate the Station Gallery on the new site as being of architectural and historical value and interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. O18.

Any person may, on or before July 23rd 2004, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Whitby notice of his or her objection to the repealing by-law together with a statement of reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. If such a notice of objection is received, the Council of the Town of Whitby will refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.
