## BY-LAW NO. 6438-11

BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 2655-89, A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE 709 CENTRE STREET SOUTH AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE

WHEREAS Section 32 of the Ontario Heritage Act provides that an owner of property designated under Part IV may apply to the Council of the municipality to repeal the by-law or part thereof;

WHEREAS Council, after consultation with the Municipal Heritage Committee shall consider an application and within 90 days of receipt of the request shall refuse the application or consent to the application and cause notice of the intention to repeal the by-law to be served on the owner and the Ontario Heritage Trust and publish notice of the intention to repeal the by-law in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality;

WHEREAS the owners of 709 Centre Street South have requested that the Bylaw passed to designate their property be repealed to address property insurance issues;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Heritage Committee has been consulted regarding the proposed repeal; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Whitby has served upon the owner of the property and upon the Ontario Heritage Trust, notice of intention to repeal the bylaw and has published such notice of intention in the local newspaper having general circulation in the municipality in accordance with legislated requirements; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed repeal by-law has been served on the Clerk of the Town of Whitby;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-law No. 2655-89 is hereby repealed in its entirety;
- 2. The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause a copy of this By-law to be registered against the property in the Land Registry Office; and

3. The Town Clerk has hereby caused a copy of this By-law to be served upon the owners of the property and upon the Ontario Heritage Trust and has published notice of the By-law in the local newspaper having general circulation in the municipality.
