TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Township of South Crosby intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, known as part of Lot 14, Concession 2, Township of South Crosby as described in Registered Instrument #7414 (house only to be designated), as a property of architectural value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1980 R.S.O. Chapter 337.

This 1½ storey house, built between 1851 and 1861, was the home of Chapman Pennock, one of the early settlers of South Crosby Township. Built of local sand stone, the house is a lovely version of the neoclassical vernacular house and is a balanced composition of good proportions.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Township of South Crosby before the 15th day of April, 1983.
