## THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF LAKEFIELD BY-LAW NUMBER 85-57

Being a by-law to designate the property known municipally as 33 Caroline Street, Lakefield, Ontario, as being of architectural and historical value or interest.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Lakefield has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises at 33 Caroline Street and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of the intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Lakefield ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property at 33 Caroline Street, Lakefield, Ontario, more particularly described as those lands and premises located in the Village of Lakefield, County of Peterborough and Province of Ontario and being composed of Lot Number 11 on the south side of Nassau Street and the west side of Caroline Street according to Registered Plans 12 and 19 for the said Village.
- 2. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property in the proper land registry office.
- The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 16TH DAY OF JULY, A.D., 1985.
