NOTICE OF INTENTION

to Designate

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Smiths Falls on the 3rd day of October, 1977, decided to designate the following buildings as properties of architectural and historical value or interest under the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, Statutes of Ontario, Chapter 122.

1. Waterworks buildings: 25 Old Mill Road

All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Town of Smiths Falls and the County of Lanark and being more particularly described as part of Block 1 on the east side of Old Mill Road, Registered Plan 13884.

Reason for designation: The three story brick building adjoining the offices was the original pumping station built for the purpose by Captain Adam Foster as a private business in the late 1800's. The three story stone office building was originally a flour mill and bears the date 1854. The first filter plant was built in 1924 in a brick building south of the original Foster building. A further extension was carried out in 1952.

NOTICE OF OBJECTION to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of October 26, 1977.
