NOTICE OF INTENTION  
to Designate

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Smiths Falls on the 6th day of September, 1977, decided to designate the following buildings as properties of architectural and historical value or interest under the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 Statutes of Ontario, Chapter 122.

1. Town Hall: 77 Beckwith St. N.  
Built: 1859  
Description: All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the Town of Smiths Falls and the County of Lanark, and being more particularly described as part of Lots 267 and 268 on the north side of Church St. E. Registered Plan 13884.  
  
Reason for Designation: This building was constructed to be used as municipal offices and is representative of the construction period.
  
2. Recreation Centre (Old Central School) 79 Beckwith St. N.  
Built: 1871  
Description: All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the Town of Smiths Falls and the County of Lanark, and being more particularly described as Lots Nos. 269, 270, 271, 272, part of Lots Nos. 267 and 268, part of Block C and part of Elmsley St, as described in Instrument No. 36746.  
  
Reason for Designation: Built for use as a public school, the building is contiguous to and complements the Town Hall and is of the same architectural design.

NOTICE OF OBJECTION to the designation may be served on the Clerk, within thirty days of October 26, 1977.
