## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Smiths Falls intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974,

Municipal Address - 34 Beckwith Street South

Reasons for Proposed Designation

The property contains a three storey stone office building fronting on Beckwith Street, a three storey stone mill building and a two storey office area adjoining the other two buildings.

The Mill Building is reported to have been constructed before 1846 and the Office Building in the early 1870 era.

Due to the prominent location in the centre of the Town and on the bend of the Rideau River adjacent to the Smiths Falls Rideau Canal Locks, its retention is important for preserving the character of the surrounding area.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Town of Smiths Falls before the 27th day of April, 1979.
