NOTICE OF INTENTION  
TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation  
of the Town of Smiths Falls on the 6th day of June,  
1977, decided to designate the building known  
municipally as 103 Old Slys Road, located on Part  
of Block, BN, Plan 13884, as a property of architec-  
tural and historical value or interest under The  
Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, 1974 Statutes of Ontario,  
Chapter 122.

SHORT STATEMENT OF REASON FOR THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION

The two storey frame residence at 103 Old Slys Road,  
located on Part of Block BN, Plan 13884, is recommended  
for designation as being of architectural and historical  
interest. This house was built by Abel Russell Ward,  
the Founder of the Municipality of Smiths Falls. The  
architectural features of the house are representative of  
the construction period and as such are worthy of  
preservation.

NOTICE OF OBJECTION to the designation may be served  
on the Clerk, within thirty days of June 15, 1977.
