CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF SMITHS FALLS
BY-LAW NO. 4330-77

A By-law to designate a certain property within the municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, designate a property within the municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to designate a certain property within the municipality was served on the owners of the property and The Ontario Heritage Foundation June 15, 1977, and was published in the Record-News on June 15th, 22nd and 29th, 1977;

AND WHEREAS no objections were received against the designation of the said property as a result of the aforementioned notices.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the Town of Smiths Falls enacts as follows:

1. The following property be and is hereby designated to be of historic or architectural value or interest:


Description: The two storey ~~frame~~ residence known municipally as 103 Old Slys Road, located on Part of Block BN, Plan 13884.

Owner: The Corporation of the Town of Smiths Falls

Reason for Designation: This house was built by Abel Russell Ward, the Founder of the Municipality of Smiths Falls. The architectural features of the house are representative of the construction period and as such are worthy of preservation.

2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the passing thereof.
