NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

Take Notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Smiths Falls has by Resolution #93-02-062, passed February 15, 1993, withdrawn its intention to designate property, including lands and building exterior, at the following location as being property of architectural and historical value or interest pursuant to Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act.

CANADIAN PACIFIC ROUNDHOUSE AND TURNTABLE

located west of Rideau Avenue and South of McCann Street on lands owned by Canadian Pacific Railway, on Registered Plan No. 1184, Part 9, Part 10 and Part 11.

Although the Conservation Review Board suggests the above named structure is historically significant, designation pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act would be ultra vires; beyond this Council's jurisdiction.
