THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, 1974

Notice of Intention to Designate Property  
of Historic or Architectural Value

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of South-West Oxford intends to designate as property of architectural or historical value or interest the following property for the following reasons:

PROPERTY: MT. ELGIN BAPTIST CHURCH

REASONS: Architectural Reasons:  
The building is an interesting and attractive example of a wood frame church of the early 1860's and is in excellent condition.

Historical Reasons:  
Residents of Mt. Elgin and District and members of the Mt. Elgin Baptist Church regard this building as being a focal point of family and village life in the past and an important feature of the social and cultural development of the village and surrounding district.

A person who objects to the proposed designation shall within thirty days after the date of the first publication of this notice serve on the Clerk of the Township a notice of objection, in writing, setting out the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts.
